

ARGENTINA

The diverse fishing opportunities and variety of fishing environments in Argentina may be without peer. It's a long stretch from the tropical jungles in the north that have warm rivers that are home to the Golden Dorado to the wind swept plains of Tierra del Fuego at the southern tip and it's trophy sea run brown trout of the Rio Grande River. The northern part of the country resembles the Amazon, while the southern tip is just 400 miles from the Arctic Circle. In the middle, there is the corridor of outstanding trout fishing on the eastern side of the Andes between Esquel and San Martin. And, between this Patagonian corridor and Tierra del Fuego, we find the giant rainbows in the unique and somewhat severe environment of Jurassic Lake and the Barrancoso River.
